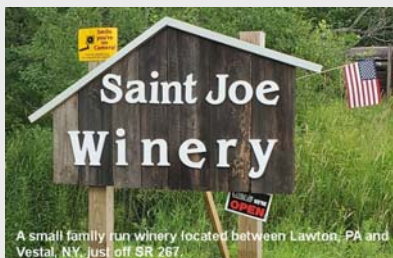
Something New
