**Butterflies. Saturday, July 9, 10 a.m.** We see butterflies in our yards, gardens, and parks, but naming them all can be tricky. Join **Tony DeSantis**, Environmental Education Specialist at Lackawanna State Park, for a morning stroll around our gardens in the West Meadow to learn which butterflies are found in the area and how to identify them. Nets will be provided. **Fee: Free-will donation.**

**Full Moon Hike. Wednesday, July 13, 8:30 p.m.** Come explore the park by the light of a full moon. End the evening around a campfire sharing snacks and stories. Bring a snack, a flashlight, and an adventurous spirit. **Fee: \$5/person; \$15/family; members, free.**

**Archery for Beginners. Saturday, July 16, 10 a.m. till Noon (also 8/20 and 9/10).** Our beginner's program is based on the National Archery in Schools Program, which makes it easy for anyone to learn. We provide the equipment, and you bring your focus. All ages are welcome.
